MYSTERIOUS CARRIAGES – LOST WITHOUT TRACE !!!

Lack of any further clues regarding the destinies of a number of carriages previously included under the 'Mysterious Carriages' heading leads me to think that they no longer exist. Thus further reference will not be made to the following unless of course they do re-appear or fresh information comes to light.

LMSR MCV (CCT) 37008 – Removed from Shamrock Quay, Southampton in 1987.

BR Mark 2 TSO 5391- Removed from Pleasure Island, Lytham St, Anne's in c2004.

BR Mark 2 FK 13509 (NIR 902 -920) - This has not previously been mentioned under this heading as it was understood that it still remained at Heysham Business Park, Middleton. It would though appear that it actually departed from this location in 2010. Enquiries as to what became of it have drawn a blank but as the other carriages removed from the location in 2010 were scrapped it is presumed this one had the same fate.
