In section 6)a)i) the disappearance of the Fruit D body from New Farm, Lacock, near Corsham was mentioned and it was presumed that it had been scrapped. It is now known that it wasn't scrapped but was moved under cover for restoration in a barn nearby, although the exact location of this is not known. Thus, it should not be considered as a deletion. Further information about its precise current location and restoration would be welcomed.
